



Underwater Archaeology Activity

Underwater archaeologists use grids to keep track of where artifacts are found. This allows other underwater archaeologists who look at a site later to find the same place an artifact was found. It also helps them figure out how the shipwrecked.

Supplies Needed:

- 9 or 16 cups (bowls also work)
- Scraps of paper
- "Artifacts" coins, rocks, etc...
- Map-it-Out worksheet



Steps:

- 1. Set out a grid of your cups
- 2. Have someone hide small artifacts in some or all of the cups
- 3. Fill the cups with your paper scraps
- 4. Use the Map-it-Out worksheet to look for artifacts and keep track of
 - where you found them
